



WHAT:



Three small teams of five will be trained to do an ethnographic survey in three areas of the city of Vancouver, B.C.: 1) downtown street people, 2) Chinatown, and 3) the working class at the Harbor Center. This event will directly support the work of Dave Hopkins and his ministry with CHIEF in Vancouver.

Tuesday to Friday: Each morning the teams will go to a different area each day and conduct a survey. After lunch the teams will meet together to share the results of their findings. Each person will be looking for more effective ways to reach each of these people groups with the gospel. In the evening the teams will have opportunities to share at the Potter's House, a place to share the gospel with the needy street people of Vancouver.

Saturday: The teams will go to the Aquarium

Sunday: The teams will worship with our brothers and sisters at Grace Vancouver PCA. After the Sunday morning service we will return to Portland.



WHEN:

WHO:

High School age teens to Adults (only 15 participants)

WHERE:

Vancouver is the largest metropolitan area in Western Canada, and third largest in Canada, with a population of 2.6 million.

Located at the southwestern corner of the coastal province of British Columbia, it is well known for its majestic natural beauty, as it is nestled between the Coast Mountains and the Pacific Ocean. OTHER:



Cost: It is anticipated that the cost will be approximately \$150.00 for the week including food and transportation. Passports: If you are interested in this opportunity you will need to have a US Passport in order to travel across the border into Canada and back again. If you do not already have one, it is advisable to get started on this now as it can take a while to process your application.

Accommodation: Arrangements are being made with Grace Vancouver PCA to use their facilities. You will need to bring a sleeping bag, pillow and sleeping mat. Training: There will be two sessions for training and both will need to be attended. They will be held during the meal time for Surveyor on March 10th and 17th. Each session will be one-half to three-quarters of an hour long.
